



Incentives for Medication Management Measures for Medicare Advantage Members

At HAP, we are committed to working with you to improve the quality of care and health outcomes for your HAP patients. We recognize the partnership between providers and patients for effective medication management. As an aspect of quality and performance, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services includes several medication management measures in its five Star Ratings.

Effective with dates of service September 1, 2021, through the end of 2021, HAP is offering **reward opportunities** to engage patients in recommended medication therapy. We will send Alternative Payment Model Entities (APMEs)/Physician Organizations (POs) lists of their HAP Medicare HMO and PPO patients eligible for the incentives. Please see incentive details below.

\$300 incentive for statin therapy

HAP will pay \$300 for each eligible patient on the list provided that has a prescription adjudicated at a pharmacy through their prescription benefit card by December 31, 2021, for the statins in the table below. Note: Details on acceptable codes will be in the letter that accompanies the patient list.

Statin	Requirements
Statin use in Patients with Cardiovascular disease (SPC)	Moderate to high intensity statin dose
Statin Use in Patients with Diabetes (SUPD)	Any statin dose
New! APMEs can also receive credit by charting an SUPD exclusion through an E&M encounter	Appropriately document statin-induced myopathies or other myopathies complicating statin use

\$75 incentive for HAP Comprehensive Medication Review (CMR)

Patients with multiple medications, chronic conditions, and high cost are identified for a CMR. During a CMR, a pharmacist will review items related to:

- Drug safety
- Efficacy
- Options for lowering drug costs

HAP will pay the provider \$75 for each eligible patient on the list provided that has a CMR performed with a HAP pharmacist no later than December 31, 2021. To complete the CMR, please ask your eligible patients to contact HAP's Medication Therapy Management team at **(866) 766-4707**.

New! Increased fee for Medication Reconciliation Post Discharge – 1111F

Currently, we reimburse providers for medication reconciliation within 30 days of inpatient discharge for HAP Medicare Advantage members if it is:

- Conducted by the prescribing physician, clinical pharmacist, or registered nurse
- Billed with CPT code 1111F

Effective October 1, 2021, we will increase reimbursement for 1111F from \$8 to \$35.
